

Open to Brood Bitch and Produce. Must have at least two, but no more than three offspring at parent's side. Brood Bitch must be intact. Offspring may be intact or spayed/neutered.

Class 1036: Best Family & Reserve

Class 1037: Working Family

Go-to-Ground

A timed event that simulates the terrier's natural instinct to hunt. The terrier enters an artificial den/tunnel to demonstrate its working ability. Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from the Go-To-Ground competition at this trial. For all classes: work is defined as baying, digging, concentrated stare, whining or biting at the bars. A break in work is defined as ceasing to work for a period of more than ten seconds. Leaving the quarry is defined as moving back in the tunnel away from quarry and out of the view of the judge. The judge may halt the work, if the judge believes the terrier is injuring itself. Copies of JRTCA trial certificate must be submitted with pre-entries or presented to the den steward at the time of judging. Cross entering is not permitted between certificate classes.

Class 1096: Pre-Novice Puppy

Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 1097: Novice Puppy

Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 1098: Novice Adult

Open to Jack Russells one year of age or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 1099: Open Puppy

Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppies which have previously achieved 100% in this class. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial. (30 sec- onds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 1100: Open Adult

Open to Jack Russells one year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 1101: Puppy Championship Certificate

Open to Jack Russells, 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 1102: 10 up to 121/2" Adult Championship Certificate

Open to any adult Jack Russell 10 up to 12½", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be sub- mitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 1103: Over 121/2 up to 15" Adult Championship Certificate

Open to any adult Jack Russell over 12¹/₂" up to 15", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work andwithout leaving quarry.)

Class 1104: 10 up to 12 1/2" Veteran Championship Certificate

Open to any adult Jack Russell 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 1105: Over 12 ½ up to 15" Veteran Championship Certificate

Open to any adult Jack Russell 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 1106: 10 up to 12 1/2" Senior Championship Certificate

Open to any adult Jack Russell 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 1107: Over 12 1/2 up to 15" Senior Championship Certificate

Open to any adult Jack Russell 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Earthdog Go-to-Ground (non-sanctioned)

A timed event that simulates the earthdog's natural instinct to hunt. The terrier enters an artificial den/tunnel to demonstrate its working ability. Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from the Go-To-Ground competition at this trial. For all classes: work is defined as baying, digging, concentrated stare, whining or biting at the bars. A break in work is defined as ceasing to work for a period of more than ten seconds. Leaving the quarry is defined as moving back in the tunnel away from quarry and out of the view of the judge. The judge may halt the work, if the judge believes the terrier is injuring itself. Open to Earthdogs up to 15" tall.

Class 1108: Earthdog Novice (non-sanctioned)

Open to earthdogs, 6 months and older, who have not scored 100% in a novice GTG at previous trials. Entries earning 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. One minute to reach quarry. May leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached. When quarry is reached, must work quarry continuously for 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another (examples include baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying) Non-sanctioned.

Class 1109: Earthdog Open (non-sanctioned)

Open to earthdogs, 6 months and older, who have scored 100% in a Novice class at previous trials. 30 seconds to reach quarry. May leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached. Work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another. Nonsanctioned.

Go-to-Ground

A timed event that simulates the terrier's natural instinct to hunt. The terrier enters an artificial den/tunnel to demonstrate its working ability. Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from the Go-To-Ground competition at this trial. For all classes: work is defined as baying, digging, concentrated stare, whining or biting at the bars. A break in work is defined as ceasing to work for a period of more than ten seconds. Leaving the quarry is defined as moving back in the tunnel away from quarry and out of the view of the judge. The judge may halt the work, if the judge believes the terrier is injuring itself. Copies of JRTCA trial certificate must be submitted with pre-entries or presented to the den steward at the time of judging. Cross entering is not permitted between certificate classes.

Class 2096: Pre-Novice Puppy

Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 2098: Novice Adult

Open to Jack Russells one year of age or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 2099: Open Puppy

Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppies which have previously achieved 100% in this class. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial. (30 sec- onds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 2100: Open Adult

Open to Jack Russells one year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 2101: Puppy Championship Certificate

Open to Jack Russells, 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 2102: 10 up to 121/2" Adult Championship Certificate

Open to any adult Jack Russell 10 up to 12½", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be sub- mitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 2103: Over 121/2 up to 15" Adult Championship Certificate

Open to any adult Jack Russell over 12¹/₂" up to 15", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work andwithout leaving quarry.)

Class 2104: 10 up to 12 1/2" Veteran Championship Certificate

Open to any adult Jack Russell 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 2105: Over 12 ½ up to 15" Veteran Championship Certificate

Open to any adult Jack Russell 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 2106: 10 up to 12 1/2" Senior Championship Certificate

Open to any adult Jack Russell 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 2107: Over 12 1/2 up to 15" Senior Championship Certificate

Open to any adult Jack Russell 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Earthdog Go-to-Ground (non-sanctioned)

A timed event that simulates the earthdog's natural instinct to hunt. The terrier enters an artificial den/tunnel to demonstrate its working ability. Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from the Go-To-Ground competition at this trial. For all classes: work is defined as baying, digging, concentrated stare, whining or biting at the bars. A break in work is defined as ceasing to work for a period of more than ten seconds. Leaving the quarry is defined as moving back in the tunnel away from quarry and out of the view of the judge. The judge may halt the work, if the judge believes the terrier is injuring itself. Open to Earthdogs up to 15" tall.

Class 2108: Earthdog Novice (non-sanctioned)

Open to earthdogs, 6 months and older, who have not scored 100% in a novice GTG at previous trials. Entries earning 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. One minute to reach quarry. May leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached. When quarry is reached, must work quarry continuously for 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another (examples include baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying) Non-sanctioned.

Class 2109: Earthdog Open (non-sanctioned)

Open to earthdogs, 6 months and older, who have scored 100% in a Novice class at previous trials. 30 seconds to reach quarry. May leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached. Work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another. Nonsanctioned.

<u>Class 2110: Earthdog Go-to-Ground Champion & Reserve (non-sanctioned)</u> 1st and 2nd place winners of Earthdog Open Class

Super Earth

A challenging GTG course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier, 6 months and older. 30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter earth several times until the quarry is reached then must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another without penalty. Classes may be combined as entries warrant. Sanctioned classes; check rules posted. Cross-entering is not permitted between certificate classes.

Class 2111: 6 up to 12 month OPEN Puppy Super Earth

Class 2112: 10 up to 121/2" Super Earth OPEN Adult Super Earth.

Open to terriers one year and older.

<u>Class 2113: Over 12½ up to 15</u>" <u>Adult OPEN Super Earth</u> Open to terriers one year and older.

Class 2114: 10 up to 12¹/₂" Veteran OPEN Super Earth Open to terriers six years and older.

Class 2115: Over 12¹/₂ up to 15" OPEN Veteran Super Earth Open to terriers six years and older.

Class 2116: 10 up to 12¹/₂" OPEN Senior Super Earth Open to terriers nine years and older.

Class 2117: Over 12¹/₂ up to 15" OPEN Senior Super Earth

Open to terriers six years and older.

Class 2118: 6 up to 12 month Puppy Certificate Super Earth.

Open to 6 up to 12 month JRT puppies which jave earned 100% in an Open 6 up to 12 month Super Earth Puppy class at this or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy of a 100% scoresheet must be presented with pre-entry or be shown to the den steward at the time of the class.

Earthdog Super Earth (non-sanctioned)

Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-to-Ground. o be run through the 10-foot Novice liner; time not to be considered.

Class 2130: YOUTH HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE

Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up. Points earned in Youth Handler, Youth Working Judge's Choice & Youth G-T-G each day

Barn Hunt (non-sanctioned)

This timed event challenges the abilities of the terrier and handler team to locate live rats enclosed in one or more tubes on a straw-bale course. (Non-Sanctioned Division) Rookie Barn Hunt - Competitors will have two minutes to find one live rat on a course that will have three live rat tubes, two rat litter tubes, and one clean (empty) tube. The clock starts when the judge is ready and signals you to release your dog at the gate. All four paws must be on the ground before you release your dog. The judge stops the clock when your dog has found the tube. You do not enter with the dog but you can encourage your dog verbally. No hand signals allowed. The dog must locate the tube to have a qualifying time. No cross-entering between classes. Maximum time allowed is two minutes. (Non-Sanctioned Division)
