## Directions to: Rabun Arena 100 East Boggs Mountain Rd. Tiger, Georgia 30576

Directions from Atlanta: Take I-85 North, keep left at the fork and take I-985 North. I-985 will end and change to GA-365N/US-23N. Follow North for 29 miles and keep left to GA-15 N/US-23 N/US-441 N. Go north for 18.5 miles and follow signs for Clayton. Turn right onto Boggs Mountain Rd, stay right on Longview, entrance to arena will be on your left. Watch for signs.

From Greenville Spartanburg Take I-85 South to exit 19B for US-76W/S Carolina 28 W toward Clemson. Follow US-76W for approximately 55 miles to Clayton, GA. Turn left onto US-441 for 4.5 miles. Turn left onto Boggs Mountain Rd, stay right on Longview, entrance to arena will be on your left. Watch for signs.

From Asheville, NC: Take I-40 West to exit 27 for US-74 toward US-19/US-23/Clyde/Waynesville/Maggie Valley/Franklin/Murphy/Atlanta. Continue onto US-74 W/Great Smoky Mountains Expy for 26 miles. Take the US-23 S ramp to US-441 S/Dillsboro/Franklin/Atlanta/US-64 W and Continue onto US-23 S for 20.5 miles. Take the ramp onto US-23 S/US-441 S and continue for 26 miles. Travel through Clayton, the arena will be approximately 3 miles South of town on the left. Turn left onto Boggs Mountain Rd, stay right on Longview, entrance to arena will be on your left. Watch for signs

From Chattanooga, TN: Take I-24 East. Take exit 185B on the left to merge onto I-75 N toward Knoxville for 19.3 miles. Take exit 20 toward US-64 E/Cleveland. Merge onto US-74 E (signs for Cleveland/US-64 E/US-11/Cherokee/National Forest/Ocean River) for 6.5 miles. Merge onto TN-40 E/US-64 E/US-74 E via the ramp to Ocoee and go 57.7 miles. Turn right onto US-64 E for 13.5 miles. Turn right onto NC-69 S for 3.5 miles. Continue onto GA-515 W for 1.1 miles. GA-515 W turns left and becomes GA-2 E/US-76 E for 31.2 miles. Turn right onto US-441. Travel approximately 4.5 miles South from when you turn onto US-441S. Turn left onto Boggs Mountain Rd, stay right on Longview, entrance to arena will be on your left. Watch for signs

- No puppies under three months of age permitted on the trial grounds. This includes the camping area. Anyone violating trial rules will be excused from all classes and asked to leave the trial site; no refunds.
- No puppy sales are permitted on the trial site.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated at any time during the trial. Anyone demonstrating poor sportsmanship will be dismissed from the grounds.
- Provide all certificates for those classes for which they are required.
- JRTCA rulebook can be downloaded at www.therealjackrussell.com A copy is also on site.
- A COPY OF JRTCA MEMBERSHIP CARD MUST BE PRESENTED or mailed with entries.

#### GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS RULES FOR EACH EVENT WILL BE POSTED AT THAT EVENT

- 1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
- 2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT organization. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
- 3. Entries MUST be within the 10 15" JRTCA height standard (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
- 4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
- 5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
- 6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family\*, Open or Working Conformation. \*Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed / neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
- 7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
- 8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling classes.
- 9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
- 10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
- 11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September. 1999 will be honored.
- 12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
- 13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier Classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the ring/den steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC certificate signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- 14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site.
- 15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
- 16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
- 17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded.
- 18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
- 19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
- 20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655) or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.terrier.com).
- 21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties, which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial hChairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
- 22. All dogs brought to JRTCA sanctioned trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial that have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
- 23. THE JUDGE'S DECISION(S) CONCERING PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS!

NOTE: No sale of Puppies at the trial site. No underage puppies on the trial grounds, including the camping area.

### **DIVISION A: RACING**

- All terriers including 4-6 month puppies, must be muzzled.
- Basket Muzzles preferred. No open-ended muzzles. No bright colored muzzles. Collars should be off.
- All terriers entering the catch area during a race without a secured muzzle will be disqualified.
- All requests for height measurement must be made by 8 AM to the racing judge. Terriers will be measured with approved JRTCA wickets.
- Other: Adult terriers one year and older, not registerable or recordable with the JRTCA. May not cross-enter into any sanctioned racing classes.
- Terriers MAY NOT cross-enter between Adult, Veteran & Senior classes.

- Child/Youth exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current calendar year; except for those children turning 5 years of age. They may start competing in Child Handler any time of the year following their 5<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- Child/Youth entries must be JRTCA members either under a family membership or under an individual Youth membership.
- Entry fee is \$5.00 a class. Please list class number, child/youth's name, birthday, and dog's name on entry form.
- Quality of the dog is NOT to be considered.
- Points are: 1st=8 pts., 2nd=6 pts., 3rd=5 pts., 4th= 4 pts., 5th=3 pts., 6th= 2 pts., & Participation=1 pt.

Child Handler. Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. This class is offered as an

- 45 introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell
- 46 **Youth Handler.** Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/ her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier.
- 47 **Youth Working Judge's Choice.** Open to any youth handler aged 10-16. Judged on the youth's knowledge of hunting and the working terrier, and ability to answer questions presented by a JRTCA Working Judge; no terrier to accompany handler in class.
- 48 **Youth G-T-G.** Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice liner; time not to be considered.
- 49 **YOUTH HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE** Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up. Points earned in Youth Handler, Youth Working Judge's Choice & Youth G-T-G each day. No entry fee.

## **DIVISION C: CONFORMATION**

- Cross entering is not permitted within or between the Open and Working Sections.
- Exhibitors participating in the working Classes must submit the appropriate JRTCA Paperwork with entries. The judge may require a copy of The National Hunting Certificate to be presented to the ring steward at the time of judging.
- Registered terriers may submit a copy of the NHC Application, signed by a JRTCA Working Judge, within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- □ Spayed or neutered terriers may only compete in Miscellaneous Conformation classes.
- Child Youth Conformation will start first.
