The following categories are MANDATORY - on both days:

- -Flat Racing and Hurdle Racing
- -Conformation *
- -Go-to-Ground (Cannot be a Novice class if you pass the Novice, you MUST move up to Open for a score.)
- -...and at least one of the following events

Go-Fur-It Earth, Barn Hunt, Brush Hunt, Rally, Agility, Thunder Tunnel, or Lure Coursing.

(Points from all events will count toward your terrier score, so the more classes you enter, the better your chances to win!)

Points awarded: 1^{st} -8pts 2^{nd} -6pts 3^{rd} -5pts. 4^{Th} - 4pts 5^{th} - 3pts 6^{th} - 2pts

This is a pre-registration event only.

*Note: For conformation classes, only one class will count toward the score each day. We will use your terrier's highest placing for scoring. Companion class does NOT count as the required conformation class



GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS RULES FOR EACH EVENT WILL BE POSTED AT THAT EVENT

- 1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
- 2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT organization. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
- 3. Entries MUST be within the 10 15" JRTCA height standard (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measur-ing devices will be available on the trial grounds.
- 4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
- 5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
- 6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family*, Open or Working Conformation. *Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed / neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
- 7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
- 8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling classes.
- 9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
- 10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
- 11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September. 1999 will be honored.
- 12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
- 13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier Classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with preentries or at the time of post entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the ring/den steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC certificate signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- 14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site.
- 15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
- 16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
- 17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded.
- 18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
- 19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
- 20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655) or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.terrier.com).
- 21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties, which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial hChairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
- 22. All dogs brought to JRTCA sanctioned trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial that have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
- 23. THE JUDGE'S DECISION(S) CONCERING PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS!

- All requests for height measurement must be made by 730 AM to the racing judge. Terriers will be measured with approved JRTCA wickets. Other: Adult terriers one year and older, not registerable or recordable with the JRTCA. May not cross-enter into any sanctioned racing classes. D.

Class 54: Child handler

Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered

Class 55: Child Go-to-Ground

Open to any child aged 5 through 9, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice tunnel; time not to be considered. If the terrier is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in the regular GTG class before It can compete in Child Go-To-Ground. (Non-Sanctioned).

Class 56: CHILD HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE

Awarded to the highest scoring Child Handler and runner-up in classes. The points are awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th place = 3 points, 6th place = 2 points, and participation = 1 point. (Non-Sanctioned, No entry fee).

Class 57: Youth handler

Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

Class 58: Youth Working Judge

Open to any youth handler aged 10 through 16 handling an adult JRT. Judged on the youth's knowledge of hunting and the working terrier, and ability to answer questions presented by a JRTCA Working Judge; no terrier to accompany handler in class.

Class 59: Youth Handler Go-to-Ground

Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judges on Youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of GTG. To be run through 10 foot novice liner. Time not to be considered. If terrier is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in regular GTG class before it can compete in Youth GTG.

Class 60: Youth Handler Agility, On Lead
Class 61: Youth Handler Agility, Off Lead

Class 62: YOUTH HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE

Awarded to highest scoring youth and runner up in class 57, 58,59, and 60 or 61.. The points are awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points, 2nd = 6, 3rd = 4, etc.....Child and Youth exhibitors must complete a minimum of child and youth conformation and GTG to qualify for the child handler high score and reserve. In the case of a tie, it will be broken by a handling class to be held in the conformation ring, judge to be decided by trial chairperson.

Conformation

All terriers are judged on the JRTCA breed standard, except Child/Youth handlers where conformation is not considered and judging is based on the handler's ability. All terriers must be exhibited on lead. Cross-entering is not permitted between the Open Section and the Working Section. JRTCA Working Conformation is open to any JRTCA-registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate (NHC). A copy of the NHC certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or presented in the ring at time of judging.

<u>Miscellaneous</u>

Class 63: Spayed/Neutered Terrier

Open to any adult Spayed/Neutered Jack Russell Terrier.

Class 64: Spayed/Neutered Working Terrier

Open to any adult Spayed/Neutered Jack Russell Terrier, which holds a JRTCA Natural

Hunting Certificate. NHC to be provided with entry form or at time of class.

Class 65: Veteran Dog & Bitch

Open to any Jack Russell, 6 years of age or older. Judged on breed standard and condition of

dog. Entrants spayed or neutered for health reasons not to be penalized.

Class 66: BEST VETERAN TERRIER & RESERVE

Open to the first and second place winners of veteran terrier classes. Non-Sanctioned, No Entry

tee.

Class 67: Companion Class

Earthdog Conformation Non-sanctioned.

Earthdog conformation classes will be held a%er the sanctioned JRT conformation classes. Open to colored terriers (dark-bodied terriers with less than 51% white), dachshunds and any earthdog breed other than JRTs.

Class 68: Earthdog Dogs Non-sanctioned.

Open to dogs one year and older.

Class 69: Earthdog Bitches Non-sanctioned.

Open to bitches one year and older.

Class 70: BEST EARTHDOG & RESERVE Non-sanctioned.

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of adult earthdog classes. No entry fee.

Suitability

Open to any adult JRT, including those which have been spayed or neutered. The dog the Judge would choose to take hunting to each guarry listed below.

Class 71: Suitability to red fox

Class 73: Suitability to raccoon/badger

Breeder's Classes

Class 74: Stud dog and get

Open to a sire with at least two, but not more than three offspring at parent's side. Judge on Breed Standard and consistency of type. Stud Dog must be an intact male. Offspring may be intact or spayed/neutered.

Class 75: Brood bitch and produce

Open to dam with at least two, but not more than three offspring at parent's side. Judged on

Breed Standard and consistency of type.

Class 76: BEST FAMILY & RESERVE

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Stud Dog and Get, Brood Bitch and Produce, and three

generations. No entry fee.

For all classes: work is defined as baying, digging, concentrated stare, whining or biting at the bars. A break in work is defined as ceasing to work for a period of more than ten seconds. Leaving the quarry is defined as moving back in the tunnel away from quarry and out of the view of the judge. The judge may halt the work, if the judge believes the terrier is injuring itself. Copies of JRTCA trial certificate must be submitted with pre-entries or presented to the den steward at the time of judging. Cross entering is not permitted between certificate classes.

NON-SANCTIONED. If entering Sanctioned SUPER-EARTH-- It MUST BE COMPLETED FIRST Open to Adult Terriers Only. Terriers to be released in a fenced area and must find quarry within 2 minutes. Earth will have multiple entrances. Owners may only give one verbal command when releasing the terrier, No other verbal assistance is permitted until after one minute has passed. The owner must remain outside the fenced area for the first minute. If the terrier has not found the entrance after one minute, the owner may enter the fenced area. Terrier must work quarry for one minute. Fastest overall time wins. Also open to other terriers. ALL entries in this class must be 15" in height or less.
