#### **GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS**

All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.

Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members, and MUST not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT organization registry. If exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds given. If violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.

Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on trial grounds.

Puppies (under 12 months of age) are not eligible for championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.

Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate from the owner or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.

Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family\*, Open or Working Conformation. \*Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The off springs at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.

A terrier bred by a Sanctioned JRTCA judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.

Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member in their household may not be entered in any phase of the competition with the exception of the Child and Youth Handling classes.

Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.

Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.

Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number, or by the Judge EXCEPT in racing. Request for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in eh same class number; OR if the classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of any under adult dog entered in Racing may call for measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races). Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September 1999 will be honored.

Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the judge's discretion.

Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-to-Ground must submit appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC certificate signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.

Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site.

All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.

Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or Trial Chairperson.

The abuse of dogs or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds in prohibited. Anyone demonstrating such behavior

will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded.

Dogs, other than JRTs, on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655) or downloaded from the JRTCA website (<a href="www.terriers.com">www.terriers.com</a>).

Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.

All dogs brought to JRTCA sanctioned trials must be current on vaccinations. No dog of any age may be brought to a trial that have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.

THE JUDGES' DECISIONS CONCERNING PLACEMENT ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS!

#### Racing Rules

- 1. ALL TERRIERS MUST BE MUZZLED! Plastic basket muzzles or close-ended cloth muzzles only. No figure eight or open-ended muzzles will be allowed. **No colored plastic muzzles allowed**.
- 2. Any terrier entering the catch area during a race without a secured muzzle will be disqualified. No refund will be given.
- 3. Exhibitors must have entries ready to race, be aware of their classes, and be ready when called. In the event a heat is missed, permission to run in a later heat is granted at the discretion of the racing judge or steward. There are no refunds for missed classes.
- 4. Once entries are loaded into the starting gate, all handlers shall proceed to the finish line and be ready to receive their terriers.
- 5. In a hurdle race, any entry going around the jumps will be disqualified.
- 6. Senior hurdle races must be run over lower height hurdles.
- 7. If a brush or lure is caught or in some way, or the movement or lack of movement of the lure delays or alters the forward motion of any terrier (i.e., almost caught or flies outside the track) the race will be rerun.
- 8. Entries must cross the finish line completely to place in a race. The finish line is the backside of the barrier. First to the hole is not necessarily first through the hole!
- 9. Any terrier engaged in fighting shall be disqualified by the Racing Judge from any further racing. No refund will be given.
- 10. Racing Champions are determined by a run-off of the first-place terrier in each class in each section. To be eligible to run in the Championship race, the terrier MUST have entered and <u>RUN</u> in both the flat and steeplechase classes. A terrier that is not entered in both classes or has not run in both classes is not eligible to run in the Championship race. In this case, the 2nd place terrier becomes eligible to run in the Championship race, assuming it was entered and ran in both classes.
- 11. Once the Racing Division has begun, NO requests for measurement will be honored.
- 12. Adult terriers may not cross-enter between Regular Racing Classes, Veteran Racing Classes and Senior Racing Classes.

Racing Course Set-up: 300-foot track; up to 14-inch-high foam jumps; foam catch barrier; "Joe Bag" as the back stop; 30 foot catch pen with trained, experienced catchers. Designed for the safety of our terriers, our goal.

Child and Youth will be the first classes of the day immediately following racing ribbons, in the conformation ring.

Class 99: Child Handler. Open to any child ages 5-9 handling a JRT 6 mo. or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about JRTs. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of JRT. Quality of dog is *NOT* considered.

Class 100 Child GTG. Open to any child ages 5-9 handling a JRT. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of G-T-G. Terrier to run through the 10-foot Novice liner, time *NOT* to be

considered. (Non-sanctioned)

Class 101: Youth Handler\_Open to any youth ages 10-16 handling a JRT. Judged on youth's ability to present

his/her dog and knowledge of JRTs. Quality of dog NOT considered.

Class 102: Youth G-T-G: Open to any youth ages 10-16 handling a JRT. Judged on youth's ability to present

his/her dog and knowledge of G-T-G. To be run through the 10-foot Novice liner, time NOT to be

considered.

Class 103: Youth Working Judge's Choice: Open to any youth handler ages 10-16 handling an adult JRT. Judged

on youth's knowledge of hunting and the working terrier and ability to answer questions presented

by a JRTCA working judge; no terrier to accompany handler to class.

Class 104: Youth On-lead Agility: Open to any youth ages 10-16 handling an adult JRT. To be run over the novice

agility course. Time is NOT to be considered. Judged on youth's ability to handle his/her terrier and

knowledge of agility SATURDAY ONLY

Class 105: Child Handler High Point and Reserve: Awarded to the highest scoring child and runner-up in Classes 98

No entry fee. (Non-sanctioned)

Class 106: Youth Handler High Point and Reserve: Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in

Classes 100, 101, 102 and 103. No entry fee.

Points for Child and Youth High Point and Reserve classes will be awarded as follows:

1st = 8 points;  $2^{nd} = 6 \text{ points}$ ;  $3^{rd} = 5 \text{ points}$ ;  $4^{th} = 4 \text{ points}$ ;  $5^{th} = 3 \text{ points}$ ;  $6^{th} = 2 \text{ point}$ ; Participation = 1 point. Exhibitors must compete in a minimum of Youth Handling and Youth Go-to-Ground to qualify for the Youth

High Score & Reserve. In case of a tie, it will be broken by a handling class to be held in the Conformation Ring;

Judge to be decided by the Trial Chairperson.

#### DIVISION D. GO-TO-GROUND

Class 107: Pre-Novice Puppy. Open to JRT pups 4-6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice class does not affect pup's eligibility to enter Novice class after 6 mos. of age. (One minute to reach quarry; work quarry 15 seconds, may leave earth and re-enter

until quarry reached).

Class 108: Novice Puppy Open to JRTs 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA

trial Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry reached; work quarry

for 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry).

Class 109: Open Puppy. Open to JRTs 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice GTG class at this or

a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppies which have previously achieved 100% in this class. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship class at this trial. (30 seconds—to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter the earth once until

quarry is reached, work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry).

Class 110: Novice Adult. Open to JRTs 1 year or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter

the Open Adult class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry reached; work quarry for 30 seconds without a break in work and without

leaving the quarry).

Class 111: Open Adult. Open to JRTs one year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice GTG class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter the earth once until

quarry is reached, work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry).

#### Class 112: <u>Puppy Championship</u>.

Open to JRTs 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open GTG class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at time of the class. 1st and 2nd place winners will be Puppy Go to Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry).

#### **Adult Championship Certificate**

Open to any adult JRTs, one year and older which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Copy of certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to the Den Steward at time of class. 1st and 2nd place winners will be GTG Champion & Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for 1 min., without a break in work and without leaving the quarry).

Class 113: 10" up to 12½".
Class 114: Over 12½" up to 15".

#### Veteran GTG Certificate.

Open to adult JRTs six years and older which hold a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Copy of certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to the Den Steward at time of class. (CROSS ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute, without a break in work and without leaving the quarry.)

Open to JRTs 9 years and older; Copy of certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to the Den Steward at time of class. CROSS ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN GTG CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute, without a break in work and without leaving the quarry.)

Class 117: <u>10" up to 12½"</u> Class 118: <u>Over 12 ½" up to 15"</u>

Class 119: Shorty Championship and Reserve GTG: (Non-sanctioned)

Open to adult JRTs less than 10". (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter; work quarry for 1 min.).

#### Other Earth dog GTG: (Non-sanctioned classes 119, 120, & 121)

Class 120: Novice Puppy / Adult. Open to any Earth dog, 6 months and older who have NOT scored 100% in this class at ANY previous trial. (One minute to reach quarry; puppies may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry reached; Adults cannot; work quarry for 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry.

Class 121: Open Puppy / Adult. Open to any Earth dog, 6 months and older who have scored 100% in the Novice class at ANY previous trial, (30 seconds to reach quarry; puppies may leave and re-enter the earth once until quarry is reached, adults cannot; must work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry

Class 122: Other Earth dog Championship and Reserve GTG: Open to any Earth dog, 6 months and older who have scored 100% in the Open class at ANY previous trial, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners are the Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute, without a break in work and without leaving the quarry. Puppies may leave and re-enter the earth.

#### **DIVISION E: Super Earth Go-to-Ground**

Super Earth: A challenging GTG course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens.

Open to any Jack Russell Terrier, 6 mos and older. 30 seconds per 30 foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter earth several times until quarry is reached then must work quarry for one minute, without a break in work and without leaving the quarry. May switch from one type of work to another without penalty.

<u>Rules</u>: no prior schooling; only the dog is allowed in the fenced area; dog owner may give verbal commands only; the clock starts the moment the dog is released. CROSS ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN Super Earth Classes.

Class 123: 6 up to 12-month Puppy Super Earth.

Class 124: 10" up to 12 ½" Super Earth. Open to terriers one year and older.

Class 125: Over 12 ½" up to 15" Super Earth. Open to terriers one year and older.

Class 127: Over 12 ½" up to 15" Veteran Super Earth. Open to terriers one year and older.

Class 128: 6 up to 12-month Puppy Champion Super Earth. Open to 6 up to 12-month JRT puppies which have earned 100% in an Open 6 up to 12-month Puppy Super Earth Class at this or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy of a 100% score sheet must be presented with pre-entry or be shown to den steward at the time of the

class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

<u>Adult Certificate Super Earth</u>: Open to JRTs, one year and older, who hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. <u>First and Second Place winners will be the Adult Super Earth Champion and <u>Reserve.</u></u>

Class 129: 10" upto12 -½", Class 130: Over12 ½"upto 15",

<u>VeteranCertificateSuperEarth</u>, Open to JRTs, six years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. <u>Firstand SecondPlacewinners willbeVeteranSuperEarthChampionand</u> <u>Reserve</u>,

Class 131: 10" upto12 ½". Class 132: Over12 ½"upto 15".

Senior Certificate Super Earth. Open to JRTs, nine years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. *First and Second Place winners will be Senior Super Earth Champion and Reserve.* 

Class 133: 10" upto 12 ½". Class 134: Over 12 ½" upto 15".

Other Earthdog Super Earth (Non-sanctioned classes 134, 135, 136)

Class 135: Novice Puppy / Adult. Open to any Earth dog 6 mo or older, who has NOT scored 100% in this class at this trial or any previous trial. 30 seconds per 30 foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and reenter earth several times until quarry is reached then must work quarry for one minute without a

break in work and without leaving the quarry.

Class 136: Open Puppy / Adult. Open to any Earth dog 6 mo or older, who has scored 100% in this class at this trial or any previous trial. 30 seconds per 30 foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and reenter earth several times until quarry is reached then must work quarry for one minute, without a break in work and without leaving the quarry.

Class 137: Other Earth dog Championship and Reserve Super Earth: Open to any Earth dog, 6 months and older who have scored 100% in the Open class at ANY previous trial, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners are the Champion and Reserve. 30 seconds to reach quarry must work quarry continuously for one full minute quarry. Puppies may leave and re-enter the earth.

DIVISION F: AGILITY We thank ALL PAWS with AGILITY, a local agility group who will be providing the equipment, manpower and Judge for this years' agility event. \*WATCH for a specific time schedule.\*

Section I: Agility (Saturday only), Practice runs 8 a.m. - 9 a.m \$3.00/run (pay at gate).

Note from Judge: Due to course changes agility classes will be posted at the gate. Every effort will be made not to skip anyone. Please help us to complete this division in a timely fashion. You will be asked to assist in adjusting the heights of the jumps.

Class 138:

Novice On-Lead. Time YPS 1.50 Open to any adult terriers that have not scored 190 points. This class is for the true beginner terrier with the intent of a pleasant experience on basic agility equipment. Handlers that drag their terriers will be seriously faulted. Course to include ramps, tunnels, and various hurdles. Although this class is for the beginner terrier, you need to have prior exposure to agility equipment. Non-Certificate. Handlers may remain in this class. May not enter in Off-Lead Classes at this trial. This course is used for the Youth On-Lead class.

Agility I Certificate: Off-Lead. Time 1.75+10% Handlers may remain in this class. Open to any adult JRTs the Agility I Certificates are earned with three scores of 190 or above. Three qualifying scores may move entrant of this class on to Agility II, Agility III and Jumpers/Game. No cross entering to this class from Agility II and Agility III. This course is used for the Youth On-Lead class. No seesaw or tire jump

in this class.

10" up to 12 ½" Class 139: Over 12 ½" up to 15" Class 140

> Agility II Certificate: Off-Lead. Time 2.25 + 10% More difficult course to include all the Agility I equipment plus two more hurdles, weave poles and seesaw. Qualifying score of 190 or better earns one leg toward JRTCA Agility II Certificate.

Class 141: 10" up to 12 ½" Class 142: Over 12 ½" up to 15"

> Agility III Certificate: Off-Lead. Time 3.00+10% Course to include all Agility I and II equipment. Weave poles increased to 12 and must end in a "gamble", Gamble to be set at 8 to 10 feet. Qualifying score of 170 points.

Scoring is time plus faults, with the lowest score getting 1st, regardless of number of faults. Five (5) faults for running the course on-lead. Five (5) faults for knocked bar and off-course. Fifteen (15) for a missed obstacle. Qualifying score of 170 earns one leg towards a JRTCA Jumpers Certificate.
